Message from Project Compass Leadership

Project Compass will bring about many positive changes for those involved in the administration of research and other sponsored projects at Emory. The new PeopleSoft Financial system will handle all OGCA processes currently handled by FAS and all OSP processes currently handled by the limited and dated OSP system. Expanded pre- and post award data will be captured together in the PeopleSoft Financial system, providing a higher level of data integrity and efficiency, as well as streamlined and expanded reporting capabilities.

One area that currently causes delays in processing proposals is budget preparation and routing. The implementation of the new system will include an electronic budget tool. This tool will handle the preparation of all budgets for sponsored programs. Currently, some departments and schools use tools that were built using Excel or similar shadow systems to develop budgets. Our new tool will provide one comprehensive tool for use throughout the University. The tool will include functions such as calculators for fringe benefits, facilities and administrative costs, and salary caps. The tool and the rates within the tool will be maintained by OGCA. This tool is anticipated to significantly streamline the budget routing and review process.

The PeopleSoft Financial System will capture further information beyond what is captured in our current systems. This information will provide Emory researchers and administrators with additional tools to monitor their awards. While there will be an adjustment period as people become acclimated with the new financial system, it is anticipated that this system will significantly improve the way research is administered at Emory.

PROJECT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Project Management Updates

- The Project Compass Steering Committee met Monday, December 15. The Steering Committee discussed the conversion process, cash management, HR/Finance interfaces, the endowment system, and utilizing forms with the PeopleSoft Financials system.
- The Conversion team welcomes Matt Carpenter as the new Conversion Team Lead.
 During December, the Conversion team focused on the General Ledger conversion process and tasks.
- As the Project Compass Team continues to push forward to the September 2009 go-live, the team has added new team members to help Emory reach its goals. New team members joined the Accounts Payable, General Ledger, Technical, Cutover, Testing, and Training teams.

Functional Teams

- The Project Team is currently collecting a list of all forms (including current forms and future suggestions) that will be required to continue the timely and accurate processing of financial transactions. Project Leadership will review the list and determine the appropriate build and implementation approach.
- The functional teams continue to develop and review the Business Process Narratives (BPNs) with business owners.
- The Testing Team continues to prepare the team for the System Test Phase of the project. The team will utilize several testing tools that will help manage and streamline the testing process.
- In January, the Testing Team will focus on test script development, unit test development, and building the test environments.
- The Conversion team is currently working on converting General Ledger data into the PeopleSoft Financial system. The team will convert 2008 ending balances and existing 2009 transactions into the new system.
- The Project Team hosted a meeting to review the Organizational Change Management strategy, including the Communication and Training approaches, as well as the Organizational Impact Analysis process. The Organizational Impact Analysis is the process of identifying how business will change for Emory staff. Once these changes have been identified, you will learn more about the changes, prior to training, to prepare you and your staff for what to expect from the PeopleSoft Financial system.
